The collection reflects Chopard's decision to work from an uncut stone, ensuring full traceability.



Presented in a diamond-set pink gold 36mm case, the 270-piece limited edition *Vacheron Constantin Traditionnelle Moon Phase* is driven by the manufacture Calibre 1410 AS/270. This high-precision moon phase complication is accurate to 122 years. The calibre bears the 270th anniversary emblem and *features the 'côte unique' finish*. 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THE MOOD?

Weekend escape meets inherited eccentricity. Think long rainy walks, carpets turned into coats and classic silhouettes with a twist that's more Britpop than Bridgerton. It was less about reinvention, more about remembering – just with better leather.

BAG CHECK:


The B Bracelet bag plays with saddlery curves and bridle-inspired hardware. The B Clip returns, softened with tapestry motifs and scuffed leather.






A CENTURY OF STYLE AND REINVENTION

Stepping into Fendi's world is like walking through a time capsule where heritage meets audacity. Since its *founding in 1925*, the Roman Maison has built a legacy of craftsmanship, innovation, and boundary-pushing design. Now, as Fendi celebrates its 100th anniversary, it does so not by looking back but by embracing the future - just as Karl Lagerfeld once envisioned in his sketches that transcended time.







1970s: A decade of expansion, where Rome's artisanal touch met the global stage. The House's designs became a staple among fashion icons.



1990s: Enter the Baguette bag. Designed by Silvia Venturini Fendi in 1997, it became a cultural phenomenon - immortalized in Sex and the City.



1980s: The era of excess and power dressing, where Fendi ready-to-wear collections made their mark. Karl Lagerfeld infused modernity into tradition.



2000s: LVMH's acquisition, global dominance, and the transformation of Palazzo della Civiltà Italiana into Fendi's headquarters, solidifying its Roman roots with contemporary ambition.

Fendi is a House of firsts. It was the first to stage a fashion show on the Great Wall of China (2007), the first to turn the Trevi Fountain into a runway (2016), and the first to seamlessly blend heritage with digital culture, collaborating with artists, musicians, and global tastemakers. Every milestone reaffirms the Maison's philosophy: "Nothing is impossible." With the unveiling of the Fendi Crest, the fusion of past and present is sharper than ever. Lagerfeld's sketch "Ieri, Oggi, Domani" (Yesterday, Today, Tomorrow) remains a testament to Fendi's enduring spirit.



Founded in Rome in 1925 by Adele and Edoardo Fendi, FENDI blossomed from a small, artisanal fur and leather workshop into a global luxury House. In the 1940s and 1950s, Adele and Edoardo's five daughters - Paola, Anna, Franca, Carla, and Alda - joined the family business, each contributing unique talents that fueled the brand's expansion and innovation.



Pomellato Together builds on the Maison's signature motif of unity, featuring rings, bracelets, and pendants with interlocking elements. The collection introduces reversible designs, a new soft bracelet with a flexible structure and a sliding mechanism that allows for adjustability. Crafted in rose gold and accented with diamonds, these pieces offer versatility



What's new for you, and for O KTA in 2025? It's shaping up to be a milestone year. We have some incredible new brands joining our portfolio, ones I'm personally excited about alongside fresh launches from our existing lineup. With both distribution and e-commerce at the core of our business, we're sharpening our focus on strategic expansion, particularly in key regional markets like KSA and Kuwait. At the same time, we're amplifying our direct-to-consumer experience through www.discoverokta.com, ensuring our community has even more access to the brands they love.

What kind of legacy do you hope to build through OKTA? With O K T A, my vision goes beyond curating conscious beauty - it's about creating and an ecosystem that fosters education, connection and



mindful living. Yes, it starts with thoughtful products, but at its core O K T A is more than a platform for conscious beauty. > but about deserving, about choosing what truly resonates. You see it in the way Emirati women carry themselves: with elegance, presence, and an unspoken assurance that beauty is as much about energy as it is about aesthetics

> What's a major challenge that reshaped your approach as a leader? One of the biggest challenges that reshaped my approach as a leader was finding the balance between assertiveness and kindness. Leadership requires trust in your own decisions, but as a woman, I've often found myself navigating the delicate space between diplomacy and decisiveness. I've learned that true leadership isn't about being liked by everyone; it's about making the right calls with integrity, even when they aren't the easiest.

> What advice do you have for aspiring Arab women entrepreneurs? When you're just starting out, there's a certain boldness in not knowing too much; you take risks more freely, without overthinking every step. But as you grow, the key is to stay fearless while refining your vision. Find your niche, no matter how simple, and own your voice in it - that will be the thread that ties everything together. Good things take time, so don't get caught up in the noise of what others are doing or how far ahead they seem. Stay in your lane, focus on strategic effort, and trust the process. Don't be afraid to ask for help. Above all, find your 'why.' That's what will carry you through the inevitable days of doubt

> If you could describe your personal style in three words, what would they be? Comfortable, timeless and mooddriven. For me, style is about feeling at ease in what I wear, choosing pieces that stand the test of time, and allowing my outfit to reflect how I feel in the moment.

> What's one beauty or wellness ritual you swear by? Icing my face in the morning has been a game-

changer - it instantly wakes me up, depuffs and gives my skin that fresh, plumped-up glow. It's like a mini facelift before coffee! Another non-negotiable in my routine is gua sha. I love taking a few back to The Fix Face Potion from Khus Khus - it's deeply nourishing and versatile enough to use on the under-eyes and lips. 



Bvlgari is shaking up the Serpenti collection with a bold new evolution, blending iconic elegance with revolutionary horology. Introducing the Serpenti Seduttori Automatic, this striking timepiece takes inspiration from the ancient symbol of the serpent – representing eternal renewal – and fuses it with Bvlgari's signature craftsmanship. Unveiled in 2025, the Year of the Snake in the Chinese zodiac, it marks a new chapter for the Maison, showcasing their first-ever in-house automatic movement for Serpenti.

Powered by the new Lady Solotempo movement, the Serpenti Seduttori wraps around the wrist like a second skin. Its sleek, flowing design is highlighted by dazzling diamond accents and a transparent sapphire case back, offering an irresistible glimpse at the hypnotic oscillating weight. Seven serpent-inspired scales bring the concept of perpetual renewal to life with every turn of the wrist. But it's not just about looks. The Serpenti Lady Solotempo brings the perfect balance of technical brilliance and sensual allure. The case contours are refined, while the cabochon-cut rubellite crown adds an unmistakable touch of femininity, making it as much a statement of style as it is a feat of engineering.

Bvlgari's in-house expertise shines through in the BVS100 movement, which follows in the footsteps of previous masterpieces like the 2020 Tourbillon and 2022 Piccolissimo. The result? Under the hood, the Spirit of Big Bang Chronograph is powered by the HUB4700, an automatic skeleton chronograph movement that's a direct descendant of the legendary El Primero—one of the world's first high-frequency integrated chronograph calibres. With modern upgrades like a low-friction silicon escape wheel, this movement offers precision and innovation that's visible from both the open dial and the sapphire case back.

The attention to detail doesn't stop at the movement. The dials match the cases in perfect harmony, with chronograph counters, hands, and hour markers all color-coordinated to match the ceramic tones. And the rubber straps? They feature a black base with a central colored inlay, creating a sleek, seamless design. It's a stunning fusion of craftsmanship and cutting-edge materials, proving once again that Hublot doesn't just follow trends – it sets them.





Tiffany & Co. Bird on a Rock Full Pavé Diamond Watch

Tiffany & Co. has taken its iconic Bird on a Rock to new heights at the 2025 LVMH Watch Week, unveiling a breathtaking new interpretation that combines high jewelry and horological mastery. The latest creation, presented in a dazzling 18k white gold case, is a true showcase of Tiffany's craftsmanship and Jean Schlumberger's legacy. The Bird on a Rock watch reimagines one of Schlumberger's most beloved designs - the 1965 brooch - with a twist that brings it to life on the wrist.

The standout feature of this piece is the diamondencrusted bird, which perches on the rotating outer ring of the dial. As the wearer moves, the bird comes to life, spinning with every gesture of the wrist - capturing the whimsical spirit of Schlumberger's original creations. Each bird is hand-sculpted from gold, set with diamonds, and finished with a pink sapphire eye. The meticulous process takes over 24 hours to complete, ensuring that every detail is perfection.

The outer ring of the dial, set with 30 baguette aquamarines, sparkles with over 3 total carats. These stones are invisibly set to amplify their radiant blue hue, adding a mesmerizing depth to the design. The dial's center is snow-set with 204 diamonds, creating a shimmering effect that lights up from every angle. All of this is framed within a 36mm case, which features 366 round brilliant diamonds totaling 2.94 carats.

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

SITTING WITH... ASEEL

Do you remember your first time on stage? The first time I stepped onto the stage was at the age of 13 when I presented a children's program on Bahrain TV. The second time was in 2005 when I participated in the Gulf Star program, and that was when I sang for the first time in front of judges, an audience, and cameras. I will never forget that moment.

What song of yours feels closest to your heart? I worked on a lot of songs a while ago, when I was more active in singing. But the song that immediately comes to mind when someone asks about my songs is "Tawbah," which was released in 2011.

Acting or singing - what's your first love? My first love is acting, knowing that the first thing I did in my life was sing. But I love it when I sing and act at the same time. The only place I can do both is in theatrical performances. In the Riyadh season, I performed theatrical works. What makes me love the theater is that I can sing, act, and dance at the same time.

How has filming in Egypt inspired you lately? I started acting at a young age, but all the years I've acted abroad don't compare to acting in Egypt, nor does the period I spent there. This is due to the long history of art and acting in Egypt. The public has a taste for art, and the time I worked in Egypt taught me and made me fall in love with acting even more.

Tell us about your role in "The Tale of Daye's Family" movie. How did you prepare for "Lam El Samasya" series? The most beautiful experience was "Daye", which is a wonderful movie that I eagerly awaited its release in cinemas. "Lam El Shamsya" was the most difficult in term of preparation. In these series, we are not only actors, but we are also spreading an awareness message and we have a great responsibility to convey the topic of child molestation in a correct and realistic way. This is a very delicate topic. We

worked on our roles and on the psychological aspect, as the psychological state of the child and the parents when molestation occurs Earrings In Rose Gold, Clash De was explained. What's the biggest shift you've seen in Saudi entertainment?

I feel that a woman's mood every day is revealed by her jewelry.

How would you describe your personal style in three words? Simple, chic and practical.

What beauty secret do you swear by? If you had asked me this question five months ago, my answer would have been different. But today, after four months of work and travel, I can say that nothing affects your beauty like adequate sleep and rest. Along with skincare products, of course, and healthy eating, the key remains sleep and exercise.

How do you stay grounded with 6M+ followers? For me, the more followers I have, the more responsibility I feel. And that's what keeps me grounded. I thank God, because being loved by so many people isn't easy. With more followers comes more love - and people become more positive about you, your posts, and what they learn from you. This makes me feel even more humble and simple.

How has your Saudi heritage shaped your artistry? Saudi Arabia means everything to me. Everything about it inspires me whether it's the stories, the heritage, the colors, the traditions, or the people. At the same time, it's a big responsibility. When I carry the name of a country, I represent it everywhere I go. So for me, Saudi Arabia is both an inspiration and a responsibility. I always try to show a beautiful image of my country. Also, the fast changes and development happening in the Kingdom inspire me to keep growing and improving myself.

You've worked with UNHCR since 2019 - why is that cause personal to you? Working with UNHCR is one of the most beautiful things that's happened in my life. The refugee issue is







What was the vision and inspiration for for her eau de parfum intense? Discover how Sisley's plant-driven innovations are transforming luxury skincare – with CEO Philippe d'Ornano revealing why Sisley is the beauty game-changer you need.

How have your parents, Hubert and Isabelle d'Ornano, influenced Sisley's identity and success, especially with its commitment to plant-based, high-performance cosmetics? My family has been in the cosmetics industry for over 200 years, starting with my grandparents in the 1930s. My father and uncle went on to create a perfume brand and another skincare brand, both of which were wellestablished. Sisley, however, started with a focus on new, promising research in skincare, rather than aiming to be a luxury brand. Our mission was always to create effective skincare and makeup and that happened even more so when we discovered how to use plants.

What were the key moments in Sisley's journey that led to your focus on plant-based ingredients? In the 19th century, the rise of synthetic chemistry revolutionized the industry, becoming the new trend and being used in everything. In the 1940s and 50s, we began using more advanced technologies, including the electron

microscope, which allowed us to extract active ingredients from plants. We can now extract between 100K and 200K actives from plants, which is incredible and changed our perspective, as a single plant is like a natural chemical factory. Between the 1960s and 70s, we discovered a new range of actives that showed great promise for cosmetics, leading us to explore further.

Sisley has long championed the power of plants in skincare. Can you walk us through how your research teams identify and develop new botanical ingredients? At the end of the day, cosmetics is a very competitive market, and that's why Sisley has succeeded as a leader in skincare. Our research focuses on two main things: first, we don't want to take too long to create a product, and second, we don't limit ourselves when it

comes to the cost of ingredients. The third factor is our expertisewe've been specialists in this field for years, and we work closely with our research team. Sisleya remains one of the most iconic anti-aging creams. When we started working on it, we aimed to create a product that wouldn't require much layering, saving time for women by providing a complete solution in one product. Our second focus was on anti-aging, creating a global cream that would deliver better efficiency over 10 years. I fought with my parents about this, as the process was very expensive, and I didn't think about the price at the time. But when we launched it, it turned out to be a success, and my parents were finally happy.

How does this set Sisley apart from other luxury beauty brands? When I travel and meet people, they often praise Sisley as one of the best products, even though they find it expensive. Many are willing to invest in their skin and self-care. Our customers are so emotionally invested in Sisley that they often know more about our products than I do. This passion led us to expand into makeup, where we've become one of the top brands, offering high-quality, fun, and trendy

products. We then ventured into haircare with our Hair Rituel line, applying the same approach. Finally, we launched fragrances, drawing from my family's artistic background, with scents like Eau du Soir and Izia Eau de Parfum becoming world-renowned. We have a great collection of high-end products, and we're also launching a new brand soon, though I can't reveal it just yet.

Middle Eastern consumers appreciate personalized beauty experiences and luxury skincare. How is Sisley catering to this market? It's very important to have a mature approach to our industry, which means providing excellent service and selling the right products to the right target audience. We've also developed Maison Sisley worldwide; we're opening a spa in Dubai in June and another in Oatar, which is currently in progress.

Having not been in the region for a while, how does you view the Middle Eastern market and consumer engagement? Do you think they are familiar with the brand? We operate in 10 countries, and I love visiting the teams to see how the market is developing, but managing everything abroad can be challenging. As for the Middle Eastern region, there's significant potential for

> growth in skincare. This region values quality, and as skincare continues to develop, we can attract more customers to high-quality products. I also see a strong passion for makeup here. Even in Europe, people didn't prioritize self-care before COVID, but we saw a shift during the pandemic. Many turned to Sisley for skincare because they trusted the safety of our products. Perfume and haircare also saw major growth during this time. The region holds great potential because people are curious about beauty, cosmetics, and makeup.

Aisha Rashid Deemas talks to ELLE Arabia about the importance of Arab female artists and how they remain an integral part of cultural dialogue, serving to enhance the legacy, history, and heritage of the region and to inspire future generations.

have been actively involved in the cultural and museum sector for nearly 20 years," says Aisha Rashid Deemas, Director General of Sharjah Museums Authority. Passionate about art and heritage in the region, Aisha is dedicated to sharing stories with communities of all ages. "My priorities continue to be sustainability, cultural preservation and community engagement. Museums play a vital role in safeguarding our heritage while fostering meaningful social connections."

Over the past two decades, Aisha has contributed to the planning and management of all 16 museums under Sharjah Museums Authority, covering archaeology, heritage, science, marine life, Islamic art and regional history. Her work includes curating exhibitions and creating inclusive spaces that welcome visitors from all backgrounds. Aisha remains focused on growing national and international collaborations and elevating Arab female artists. "The contributions and achievements of Arab female artists have been instrumental in shaping the region's cultural identity," she says. "Through their innovative works, they've addressed social, political, and cultural themes, offering nuanced perspectives and fostering deeper understanding of the Arab world's complexities."

Reflecting on artists like Najat Makki, Karima Al Shomely, Samia Halaby, Tamam El-Akhal, Baya Mahieddine and Thuraya Al-Baqsamim - featured in the Lasting Impressions series - Aisha's commitment to shared Arab heritage is clear. Emirati artists Makki and Al Shomely highlight themes of heritage, traditional attire and adornments. Each artist explores memory, tradition, and women's roles and identities in society. Samia Halaby's work captures Palestinian history through visual storytelling, while Tamam El-Akhal's art reflects the displacement and identity struggles of the Palestinian people. Thuraya Al-Baqsami and Baya Mahieddine spotlight women's roles in society, blending art and activism to explore identity, femininity and self-expression.

"Collectively, these artists have challenged stereotypes, promoted dialogue, and inspired future generations," Aisha notes. "Their impact extends beyond art, influencing education, activism, and cultural policies. Through artistic experimentation and inclusion, they ensure their narratives remain central to the Arab world's evolving identity." With more exhibitions and programs ahead, Sharjah Museums will continue to connect people to history amplifying women's voices on regional and international platforms.

"Realism became my way of expressing my love for nature, capturing fleeting moments and transforming them into timeless artworks. Over the years, I refined my skills, using art to recreate what I see and to tell meaningful stories," she shares.

With new outposts in London's Harrods and Monte Carlo, they are setting the stage for Lebanese cuisine to take its rightful place on the global fine-dining scene. In this exclusive interview, we sit down with the mother-daughter powerhouse to talk about their Gulf region plans, family traditions, and the art of elevating Lebanese food to new heights.

Em Sherif Café has become a culinary institution. What's the secret to keeping Lebanese cuisine both authentic and exciting for a modern audience?

Chef Mireille: The heart of Em Sherif has always been about preserving tradition while making it modern and relevant to today's audience. Authenticity is key, but so is evolution. We respect our heritage by staying true to time-honored techniques and flavors, yet we're constantly innovating – whether it's through presentation, ingredient sourcing, or how we engage with a more interested and knowledgeable generation of diners. At the end of the day, Lebanese cuisine is about warmth, generosity, and shared experiences, and that's what keeps it exciting no matter the era and market we're in.

From Beirut to Dubai, Abu Dhabi, and beyond, how does the UAE influence the evolution of Em Sherif Café's menu and experience?

Chef Mireille: The UAE is a melting pot of cultures and restaurant experiences, and that global dynamism naturally seeps into our approach at Em Sherif Café. While we stay deeply rooted in Lebanese tradition, the diversity and cosmopolitan nature of cities like Dubai inspire us to be more experimental.

THE **MOTHER-DAUGHTER** DUO BEHIND **EM SHERIF'S** EXPANSION

With roots in Lebanon and a vision for the future, Chef Mireille and Yasmina Hayek bring the soul of Lebanese cuisine to the UAE and beyond





We've incorporated regional influences and adapted to the experience-driven dining scene while maintaining the soul of our cuisine and what we do.

You've built an empire rooted in Lebanese hospitality. What's a small but powerful gesture that makes a dining experience truly special?

Chef Mireille: The smallest gestures are often the most meaningful. Our ethos at Em Sherif is all about making people feel at home – the power of nostalgia, the Lebanese table "our way". True hospitality for us is in the details, in making every diner feel like they are home but also a valued guest.

If you had to create a "Daily Dish" inspired by the UAE, what flavors or ingredients would you incorporate?

Chef Mireille: I would love to create such a dish! Imagine a slow-cooked lamb infused with bezar (Emirati spice blend) and saffron, served over a freekeh, with a hint of date molasses perhaps for a touch of sweetness. It would be a homage to the region's rich flavors while keeping it unmistakably Lebanese (and therefore Em Sherif) at heart.

Yasmina, you grew up surrounded by food and hospitality. What's a childhood memory of your mother's cooking that still inspires you today?

Yasmina Hayek: One memory that always stays with me is watching my mother prepare kibbeh from scratch. She would grind the meat by hand, meticulously shape each piece, and make sure the balance of spices was just right. It was a labor of love, and I remember being fascinated by her passion, precision, and dedication. That attention to detail and respect for tradition continues to inspire the way I cook today.

You originally wanted to be a doctor – do you see any similarities between working in a lab and working in the kitchen?

Yasmina Hayek: Absolutely! Both require discipline, precision, and a deep understanding of how elements interact. In medicine, you work with chemical reactions, and in the kitchen, you create chemistry with flavors! Cooking is also about nourishing people, just in a different way. And plus, the vibe of a busy

and vibrant kitchen is more appealing to me than a medical lab!

With locations in London and Monte Carlo, how do you ensure Em Sherif's Lebanese soul shines through in every city?

Yasmina Hayek: It's all about staying true to the essence of Lebanese cuisine and our vision while highlighting and respecting local ingredients and audience. We bring in key Lebanese dishes, maintain traditional cooking methods and knowhow, and focus on delivering that signature warmth that defines our way of doing things. Every Em Sherif location should feel like stepping into a piece of Beirut, no matter where it is in the world.

You've trained in Michelin-starred kitchens
- what's the most unexpected lesson you've
brought back to Em Sherif?

Yasmina Hayek: One of the biggest lessons I learned is that simplicity, when executed perfectly, can be just as powerful as complexity. In Michelin-starred kitchens, every element on a plate has a purpose. I bring that philosophy back to Em Sherif every day, refining dishes that tell a story without unnecessary distractions.

If you could introduce one Lebanese dish to the global fine-dining scene that isn't widely known, what would it be and why?

Yasmina Hayek: Moghrabich. It's a pearl-shaped Lebanese semolina pasta, with different toppings. It is a dish that has depth, texture, and a rich, comforting flavor profile that I believe has a beautiful fine-dining adaptation. It's Lebanese comfort food at its best, that we work with across our outlets and I'd love to see it more celebrated.

What's the one dish that always sparks a fun debate between you two in the kitchen?

Chef Mireille: Kibbeh Nayé! I've always believed in keeping it traditional, the way my mother taught me – perfectly seasoned raw meat, kneaded with just the right balance of flavors.

Yasmina Hayek: And I've always loved experimenting with it, thinking of ways to modernize the experience while still respecting its roots.

Chef Mireille: But I have to say, I'm glad we had this debate because it led to Yasmina launching the Kibbeh Nayé Sourdough Sandwich at Em Sherif Deli, and it has become one of our best sellers!

Running a family business comes with unique challenges – how do you balance tradition with innovation without stepping on each other's toes? Chef Mireille: It's all about trust. I trust Yasmina's vision, and she respects the foundation we've built, along with the rest of our family. We have moments of disagreement, of course, but we always come back to our shared goal: celebrating and highlighting Lebanese cuisine in our best way possible.

Yasmina Hayek: My mother has set such a strong foundation that it allows me to experiment without losing sight of our identity. We may push each other at times, but at the end of the day, we're always aligned on what truly matters.

If Em Sherif Café were to create a special menu inspired by your mother-daughter journey, what would be the star dish and why?

Yasmina Hayek: Not to sound repetitive but I would say it would have to be Moghrabieh – a dish that symbolizes our ability to reinvent Lebanese classics while keeping nostalgia at its core. We've embraced different iterations of it across our outlets, from Traditional to Lobster, Seafood, Mushroom, Saffron, and even Caviar Moghrabieh. Each version represents a balance between honoring tradition and elevating it, much like our journey together. It's a dish that speaks of comfort, elegance, and possibilities of Lebanese culinary heritage.

Dining at Aman Tokyo was an experience in itself. The restaurant, Arva, provided a front-row seat to Tokyo's grandeur, with panoramic views of the Imperial Palace Gardens and, on clear days, the snow-capped peak of Mount Fuji. Every meal was a celebration of flavors, with dishes crafted from the finest seasonal ingredients. For a more intimate experience, Musashi by Aman served Edomae-style sushi, prepared with precision and artistry. In the afternoons, The Lounge by Aman offered a tranquil setting to enjoy a traditional Japanese tea service, complete with delicate sweets.

RELAX & UNWIND

Aman Tokyo's spa spans two entire floors, making it one of the largest and most comprehensive wellness sanctuaries in the city. My experience at the spa was pure bliss - the treatment rooms, equipped with their own relaxation areas and steam showers, provided a holistic escape from the bustling day. The massage was both rejuvenating and deeply soothing, leaving me in a state of absolute tranquility. The 30-meter heated





indoor pool was another standout feature, offering a breathtaking perspective of Tokyo from the 33rd floor. Floating in the warm water while taking in the endless skyline and enjoying dried fruits and tea was the perfect bridge between sightseeing and heading out to dinner.

Set in the prestigious Otemachi district, Aman Tokyo's prime location makes exploring the city effortless. The hotel is within walking distance of Tokyo Station, granting easy access to the nationwide bullet train network. This made my journey from Osaka to Tokyo seamless and exhilarating. MAROON BELLS IN ASPEN, UNITED STATES

In Aspen, you take a shuttle bus that drops you at the entrance to this stunning valley. From there, you trek through bountiful greenery, passing flowing lakes, snowcapped mountains, and breathtaking views all around.
